16 Stavanger Drive

Decision/Direction Required:

To set the parking requirement for a Bakery and approve parking relief for the overall site at 16 Stavanger Drive.

Discussion – Background and Current Status:

An application was submitted to accommodate a change of occupancy for a Bakery within the plaza located at 16 Stavanger Drive. As the Bakery Use is unspecified in the Development Regulations, it is to be set by Council as per Section 9.1.1. It is recommended that the parking requirement for Retail Use be used from the current Development Regulations, which would require 3 parking spaces to be provided. This standard is also in line for the proposed Retail Use within Envision.

The current occupancies within the Building include two low traffic Retail uses, a dance studio, Warehouse, the proposed Bakery and one vacant suite. There are currently 47 parking spaces on-site which adequately accommodated the existing occupancies. As per the table below, the Development Regulations require current occupancies to provide 52 parking spaces. To accommodate the existing uses in the Building, parking relief for 5 spaces is requested subject to Section 9.1.2(1) of the Development Regulations.

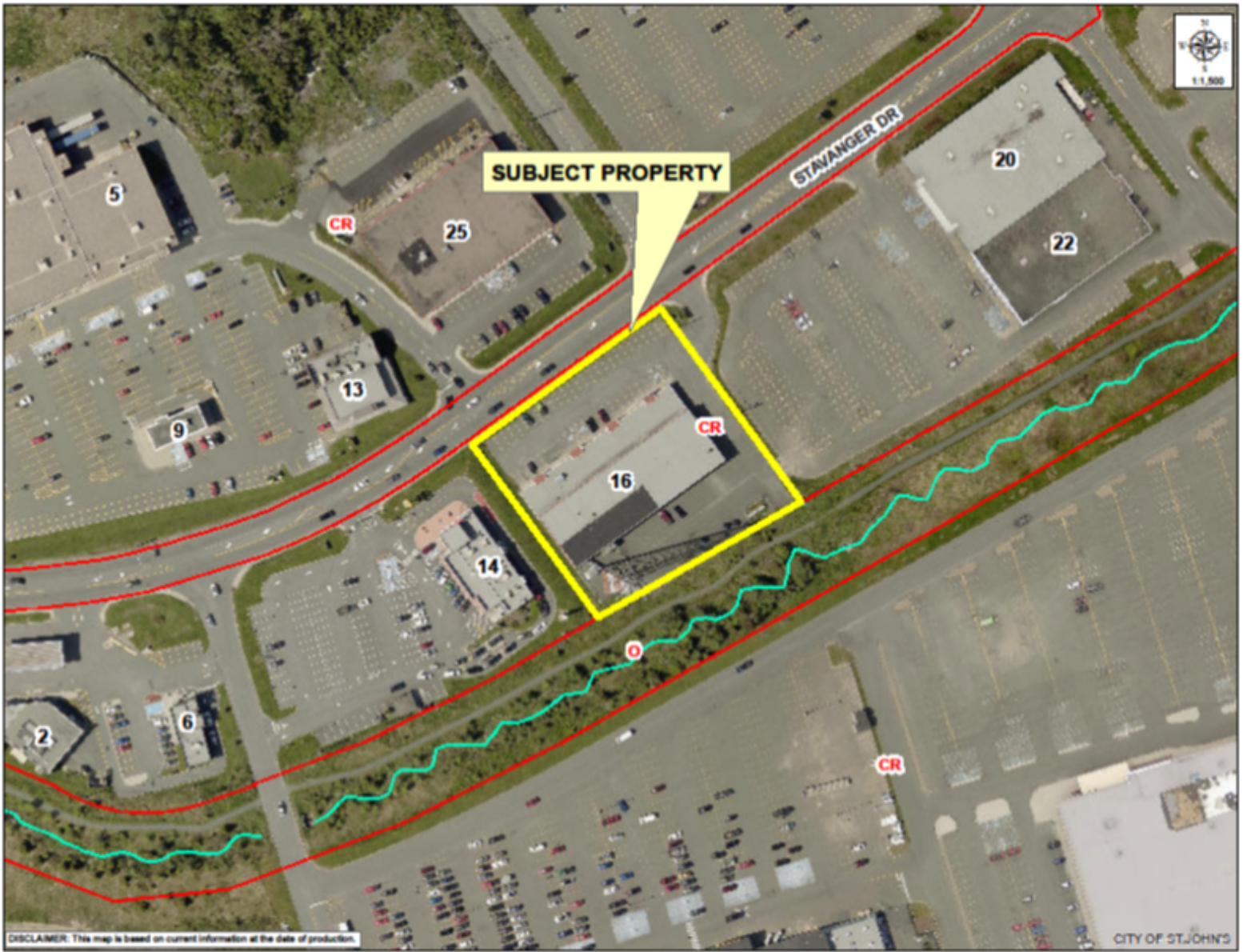

Decision/Direction Required: To set the Terms of Reference for a Land Use Assessment Report regarding additional height for a Single Detached Dwelling at 1 Ozark Place.

Discussion – Background and Current Status:

An application was submitted for a Single Detached Dwelling with an overall height of 3 storeys at 1 Ozark Place, which is zoned Residential Low Density (R1). Under the St. John's Development Regulations Building Height is not identified within the R1 Zone. Under the St. John's Municipal Plan, the Residential Low Density District outlines Building Height and Area as generally low profile, not exceeding two storeys and a Floor Area Ratio of 0.5. Subject to a Land Use Assessment Report (LUAR), individual projects may be zoned to allow heights up to three storeys with a Floor Area Ratio not exceeding 1.0.

Although the Zone is not changing, the three storey height is greater than surrounding development and it is therefore important to evaluate how the proposal will affect the surrounding area. Subject to Section 5.6.3 "Council may require a Land Use Assessment Report to evaluate any proposed land use, development and/or situation that affects the policies contained in the Municipal Plan". Therefore, it is recommended that a Land Use Report be completed to show how the overall mass and scale of the Dwelling fits within the neighbourhood.

The proponent shall identify significant impacts and, where appropriate, also identify measures to mitigate impacts on land uses adjoining the subject property. All information is to be submitted under one report in a form that can be reproduced for public information and review. The numbering and ordering scheme used in the report shall correspond with that used in this Terms of Reference and a copy of the Terms of Reference shall be included as part of the report (include an electronic PDF version with a maximum file size of 15MB). A list of those persons/agencies who prepared the Land Use Assessment Report shall be provided as part of the report. The following items shall be addressed by the proponent at its expense:

A. Elevation & Building Height

- Provide elevations of the proposed Dwelling.
- Identify graphically the exact location with a dimensioned site plan:
 - Location of the proposed Dwelling in relation to neighbouring Dwellings;
 - Proximity of the Dwelling to property lines and identify setbacks; and
 - Identify the height of the Dwelling.
- Provide street scape views/renderings of the proposed Dwelling in comparison to existing Dwellings from the following Streets:
 - Along the property frontage at Ozark Place;
 - Along the Side Yard (Flanking Street) at Redberry Street; and
 - Along the Street at Pepperwood Drive (showing the Rear Yard).

I am submitting the petition for adding solar-powered, button-activated flashing light posts on both side of the crosswalk on Frecker Drive/United Church. It would be the same concept as the one on Park Avenue/Newfoundland T'Railway.

The petition is at 265 signatures and the petition for 200 signatures in 24 hours. I tried to keep it local to Cowan Heights only. However, it seems as though some people's servers picked up different locations. For example, my husband signed the petition as his location pings as Mount Pearl when he is obviously in Cowan Heights. Another friend was shown as a Montreal location when in fact, she lives in Cowan Heights as well.

I also want to mention in more detail that last winter, I witnessed a car almost hit a guy walking on the cross walk around 4.45 PM (just as it was getting dark). The car screeched their tires and came extremely close to hitting the guy. I stopped to chat with him and although he was okay, he was pretty shaken. Also, when I walk back from CHE after dropping [REDACTED] off, I am not even comfortable enough to use the crosswalk to walk back to my house. I just cross the street closer to Burton when there are no cars present. It's pretty bad it has come to that.

Here is what I wrote in the petition:

This crosswalk is used by many kids who go to Cowan Heights Elementary. The kids walking with their parents and the kids who are walking/riding their bikes on their own, are using this crosswalk as a means to get onto the United Church parking lot and take the path to get to Cowan Heights Elementary.

My first grader and I walk to school daily. We use this crosswalk every single day. I can't count the amount of times that cars have sped past us while we were getting ready to step onto the crosswalk or while we were walking on the crosswalk. Today, I wore my bright yellow coat and a car still "didn't see us on the crosswalk" and sped on through the crosswalk.

As we approach the crosswalk, I can see from a distance that kids are hesitant to step onto the road to cross because cars just keep going by without stopping. Sometimes, it takes at least 2 cars to drive past until a decent person finally stops to let a group of kids cross.

My child is nowhere near ready to walk alone but if something isn't done about this crosswalk, then when he is ready to walk alone, I'll still have to walk with him to make sure that he can cross this crosswalk safely.

I've exchanged comments about this crosswalk with other parents who walk with their kids as far as the crosswalk to ensure that their kids can cross safely.

I'm asking the City of St. John's to install a solar-powered, button-activated, flashing crosswalk that will prompt cars to stop (just like the one at Park Avenue/T'Railway in Mount Pearl). This would also work at night when adults (and kids) use this crosswalk and they can cross the road safely. Last winter, I witnessed an adult nearly get hit in the dark while crossing on this crosswalk. Luckily, he was ok.

Please sign this petition to keep the kids (and all the residents using this crosswalk) safe.

As you know, there's a lot of stories from this particular crosswalk and there are multiple posts and threads of comments regarding this crosswalk.
