Decision points - why are we engaging

- There is a voice within the community advocating for improved service in sidewalk snow clearing. Messages have focused on the importance of sidewalks for those who rely primarily on active transportation and those who use public transit to get around.
- Key decision point for Council is <u>how</u> to improve the service levels in a way that is effective, i.e. there is a recognition of improvement, <u>and</u> the decision considers the cost of making the improvements.
 - To make these decisions it is imperative that the city understand what the issues are, and for whom, in the current level of service and where the improvements will have the greatest impact.


