Development Regulations Number 721, 2021

BACKGROUND

The City of St. John's wishes to allow a residential development in the flood plain buffer of Rennie's River at 6 and 8 Winter Avenue. See attached Council Decision Note dated May 12, 2021 for Background Information on this amendment.

PUBLIC CONSULTATION

The proposed amendment was advertised on three occasions in *The Telegram* newspaper on June 5, 12 and 19, 2021. A notice of the amendment was also mailed to property owners within 150 metres of 6 and 8 Winter Avenue and posted on the City's website and social media.

ST. JOHN'S DEVELOPMENT REGULATIONS AMENDMENT NUMBER 721, 2021 The City of St. John's Development Regulations is amended by:

- 1) Repealing Section 11.2.4 (2.1) Development within Lands Adjoining Bodies of Water and Flood Hazard Areas and substituting the following:
 - (2.1) Council may permit a food bank building in the flood plain of the Waterford River behind the Corpus Christi Church on Waterford Bridge Road. Council may permit residential development in the flood plain buffer of Rennie's River at 6 and 8 Winter Avenue.
