Hours of operation will be Monday - Friday 3 – 8 p.m. Saturday 10 a.m. - 3 p.m. and will be by appointment only. There will be one student per lesson each one lasting for 30 or 60 minutes with a maximum of 10 lessons per day. There will be 2 part time instructors including the applicant.
