Discussion – Background and Current Status:

An application was submitted to construct a new Singled Detached Dwelling at 560 Back Line. A portion of the rear yard is located within the Floodplain Buffer. Council previously approved an Accessory Building within the Floodplain Buffer for this site. The applicant has since submitted new plans, which now show grading and landscaping in the buffer for the rear yard and a portion of the driveway also extends into the buffer, to provide access to the Accessory Building.
