Decision/Direction Required: Seeking Council approval of road closures associated with the 2025 Canada Games.

Discussion – Background and Current Status: The 2025 Canada Games are requesting several road closures to accommodate various events and venue set up. A traffic control company has been contracted to provide traffic plans and implement road closures. RNC have been engaged, and the Provincial Government have been consulted where required. Canada Games will contact all businesses and residents who are directly impacted by these events, and will maintain local and emergency access when possible.

Criterium Cycling Event:

- Saturday, August 16
- Road closures in effect from 5:00am 8:30pm.
 - Water Street, from Harbour Drive/Waldegrave Street to Cochrane Street
 - Harbour Drive, from Water Street to Prescott Street
 - All roads connecting with Water Street and Harbour Drive: Adelaide Street, George Street, Becks Cove, Bishops Cove, Clifts Bairds Cove, Prescott Street, St. John's Lane.



Mountain Biking Event:

- Monday, August 18 to Sunday, August 24
 - Road closure in effect daily from 5:00am 5:30pm.
 - Allandale Road, approximately 450 meters from the end of the road.
- Local access to three homes in that area will be maintained, with the exception of race times.
- Closure will not impact access to the golf course parking lot.



Bicycle Time Trials:

- Monday, August 11
- Road closures in effect from 3:00am 3:30pm
 - Team Gushue Highway, from Topsail Road to Goldstone Street
 - o George's Pond Road, from Blackmarsh Road to Team Gushue Highway
 - Brier Avenue, from New Pennywell Road to Team Gushue Highway
 - Kenmount Road, eastbound Team Gushue Highway on ramp southbound
 - Kenmount Road, westbound Team Gushue Highway on ramp northbound
 - Kenmount Road, westbound Team Gushue Highway on ramp southbound
 - o Team Gushue Highway onramp Kelsey Drive
 - o Team Gushue Highway offramp Kelsey Drive
 - Team Gushue Highway onramp Goldstone Street
 - Kelsey Drive/Goldstone Street, eastbound has two lanes closed between the onramp and offramp.
 - Kelsey Drive/Goldstone Street westbound will be converted to two way traffic.
