The property is zoned Commercial Office Highway (COH) where the minimum Building Line Setback is 6 meters. However, Council has the authority to establish or re-establish the Building Line for any existing Street. The proposed Building Line Setback for the Lot will be 5.27 meters from Portugal Cove Road.
