Title: 20 Gower Street, Designated Heritage Building Window

Replacement

Decision/Direction Required:

To seek approval for replacement of windows of a Designated Heritage Building, located at 20 Gower Street.

Discussion – Background and Current Status:

The City has received an application for window replacements at 20 Gower Street. The subject property is located in the Residential Downtown District and Zone, Heritage Area 1 and is designated by Council as a Heritage Building.

Any exterior alterations to a Designated Heritage Building require Council's approval. At the May 13, 2019 Council meeting, Council directed that minor maintenance applications for designated Heritage Buildings can be evaluated by staff and sent directly to a Council meeting for Council's approval.

The applicant is proposing to replace the windows on the front façade with vinyl single-hung windows. Initially the applicant was proposing to remove the stained glass windows currently installed in the top sash (upper glass portion) of the bay windows because they are damaged. There are also storm windows attached to the bay windows which the applicant wishes to remove. However, the stained glass is a character-defining element in the Statement of Significance for this building and therefore removal of the stained glass would not be permitted. As a means to replace the windows while maintaining the stained glass, the applicant is proposing to repair and restore the original stained glass window sashes and install the top sashes behind the new single-hung windows. From the outside, the windows will maintain the same look as stained glass windows with storm windows placed over them. As this solution will maintain the same appearance from the outside, it is recommended to approve the renovation as proposed.


