To seek approval for a Crown Land Grant for 3.13 hectares of land for a metal recycling yard on Incinerator Road for Walker Metals Inc.

The Provincial Department of Fisheries and Land Resources has referred an application to the City requesting a grant for a parcel of land comprising an area of 3.13 hectares on Incinerator Road, west of 200 Incinerator Road. The applicant has proposed a metal drop off and sorting area, a vehicle crushing/holding area and a warehouse. This industrial use is permitted in the Industrial General (IG) Zone.
